

They have **published** numerous articles for organizations including The Foundation for Economic Education, Homeschooling Today, the John Locke Foundation, TEACH







Across South Carolina, we are focusing on the Season of Prayer for State Missions with "Pray Radically" as our theme for 2015. Our focal Scripture passage, Acts 4:31, reminds us to prioritize our activities with prayer, "After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly." As we learn more about this year's mission focus areas, we can choose to "Pray Radically," to speak the truth of God boldly, and to give generously. Through this time of focus, South Carolina Baptists can know better how to pray and give. God is providing opportunities and bringing together people from other countries

and across the state so South Carolina Baptists can meet their needs, building relationships that will allow the Gospel to be spoken boldly. Through this year's week of prayer, we want to open our eyes to what is God is doing. We are reminded that He is still able to shake the ground. As you learn more about this year's focus areas, you are asked to pray radically and to give generously to the Janie Chapman State Missions offering so the Gospel can continue being shared.



Our seven week Evangelism Class will start soon – September 16<sup>th</sup>, Wednesday nights 6:30-8:30pm. We'd love for everyone to take this "class" every semester so we can create a culture of evangelism and cover all the neighborhoods in our community. Those who took this class before will be there to help guide those taking it for the first time. If you're

not ready to share your faith with strangers yet, you can just go along and watch others share the Gospel. Or you can practice sharing with one of our church members who will pretend to be a non-Christian. Either way, someone who's already taken the class will guide you through it! By depending on God's strength, you can do this!

Dear Tega Cay Baptist,

Our deepest gratitude for your support and commitment to help us better serve our neighbors with hosting our food pantry. This will help me provide a greater nutritional variety to our homeless neighbors and families with children in greatest poverty.

As we have recently celebrated our two-year anniversary we have helped 80 people in our town improve their living situation. Many on the streets have found refuge in our partner shelters, others have fought and conquered addictions through our placement in rehabs, others have been stabilized with sharing expenses with roommates, and a new segment have received the support and counseling to escape eviction and remain in their apartments. During this process the need to meet their physical needs through practical food supplementation has been a blessing to all of them. Most importantly we have seen 17 salvations this year! A total of 36 for our two years of bringing the gospel to all we share food and relief with.

Rejoice with us in knowing you are a part of this ministry. As you experienced first-hand, our children's outreach has exploded. We impact the lives of 30 children, 11 families weekly. We have also counseled two pregnant teenagers this summer that decided to have their babies. Please pray for them as the days ahead are challenging.
