Prayer Time

Did you know that every Jewish Feast and Holiday established in the Old Testament by God points us to Jesus?

Because there is both a Jewish civil calendar and a Jewish religious calendar and both differ from ours it can be confusing to establish time lines. This past Monday (Sept. 10) was Rosh Hashanah or the "Civil New Years Day". It is also the first day of what today is referred to as the "Days of Awe" which culminate 10 days later (Wed. Sept. 19) in Yom Kippur or the "Day of Atonement". The Feasts, Festivals and Holy Days are outlined in the book of Leviticus.

At this Wednesday's Prayer Meeting we will talk about Yom Kippur and how God uses His Word to demonstrate His plans and illustrate His purposes.
