Prayer Time

Did you know that every Jewish Feast and Holiday established in the Old Testament by God points us to Jesus?

Because there is both a Jewish civil calendar and a Jewish religious calendar and both differ from ours, it can be confusing to establish time lines. Monday (Sept. 10) was Rosh Hashanah or the "Civil New Years Day". It is also the first day of what today is referred to as the "Days of Awe" which culminate 10 days later (Wed. Sept. 19) in Yom Kippur or the "Day of Atonement". The Feasts, Festivals and Holy Days are outlined in the book of Leviticus.

This past Wednesday in our Prayer Time we talked about Yom Kippur and saw how God uses His Word to demonstrate His plans, illustrate His purposes and point us to our Savior.

Each week the devotion, discussion and prayers help draw us closer to God and each other allowing us to encourage each other and show the world what He means by FAMILY. We invite you to come even if you choose not to pray out loud He hears and sees our hearts.
